Pre-Wedding Consultation



A consultation is one of the best things you can do with each of your vendors as a general rule of thumb but we like to meet with you to learn more about you as a couple. It's a great time to hear about your wedding plans, what you are looking for and what you have planned so far.

During this meeting you get to know me better too, which is extremely important. I'm going to be with you all throughout your wedding day documenting all of the special moments so it is important that you feel comfortable with me.

During this meeting you also get to see all of the different albums, guest books, prints, save the date cards and so much more that I offer! Usually, I hold my wedding consultations at my studio in Media, PA.

Engagements



This is such an important session for you both as a couple and for us as your photographers. The engagement session allows you to have a professional photo session prior to your big day.

This helps us feel more comfortable with each other come the day of the wedding!

Styling engagement sessions is super fun!

If you have a hobby together, want picture with your pet or just photos in your home town, these sessions are natural and relaxed.

These photos can also be used for a custom designed guest book, save the dates and much more!





Wedding Day Getting Ready

Most people think that the wedding starts with the ceremony. While that may be the case for the guests, it is not for the bride and groom. The getting ready photos help tell the story of your day. We normally start photographing while the bride is getting her hair and makeup done.

During this time we are capturing all of the details that have been months in planning: the dress, flowers, jewelry, invitations, etc. We are also capturing all of the candid expressions and moments with your bridal party and family.

The First Look

Something that we suggest for some weddings is a first look. For the "First Look" we find a private location where we will have the bride and groom meet before the ceremony. This is the first time they are seeing each other on their wedding day and can be very emotional.

We ask the family and bridal party for privacy so that it is just the two of you. The first look is nice because it allows the bride and groom to have time for portraits together when they are freshly dressed up. This is always a really emotional part of the day that even has your photographer's tearing up.

1. Couple and Bridal Party

This is where we can be creative and capture images that are truly unique to you as a couple. These photos are not "posey" or "stiff". We set up the location and find the perfect lighting conditions for these photos to be natural and expressive.

2. Family and Group Shots

We know and appreciate the importance of these photos. A few weeks before the wedding we request a list of all of the family and group shots that you would like us to take. This way we can make sure we don't miss a photo or person in the shot. We will organize and get everyone together for you. Usually these photos are taken after the ceremony.

The Ceremony



This is what the entire day is centered around and we are very aware of our role as a "fly on the wall" so to speak. We are discreet in capturing all of the key moments while not drawing any attention to ourselves.



The Reception

Party time! Now that you are married it's time to go cut a rug and eat that delicious cake you've been dreaming of since the taste testing with the baker. From the first dance, to toasts, cutting the cake and rocking the dance floor, we focus on capturing you and your guests having a good time. With two photographers we are able to provide you with a wide variety of candid shots!
